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Objective

BENEFICIARIES

The beneficiaries of the workshop will be people affected by different kind of physical and mental disabilities. Those who will organize and run the workshop will be the young YOU.COM volunteers.

The idea of the workshop comes from:

1. The associative commitment of TULIME to help people with disabilities in Tanzania.
2. EVS project from TULIME in cooperation with two associations (Vivaio Ibervillea & Officina22) helping people with disabilities contributing to their social inclusion
3. The experience of a group of TULIME members in Turin who held a workshop on creative recycling addressed to disabled children in a school.

GOALS

1. Contribute to strengthen the knowledge of YOU.COM volunteers in organizing groups for the workshop and their implementation
2. Make the workshop as a recreative moment as an alternative form for the development of some personal abilities of the addressees (craftsmanship, communication, interpersonal) contributing to the relation between the tutor and the participants with disabilities.
3. Spread the idea of recycling as a methodology for organizing recreational activities for young people who have less opportunities.
4. Promote YOU.COM projects, its goals and methodology.

Outline of content

RECYCLED MATERIALS AND FINAL PRODUCTS

Recycled materials will be sartorial waste, jute bags, bicycle inner tubes, woodworking wastes, leather wastes..

METHODOLOGY: Workshops will be held according to the methods leading the activities of YOU.COM project, as to say:

1. YNFLM (YOUTH NON FORMAL LEARNING METHODOLOGY): activities of non formal education used by social workers



- 2. LEARNING BY DOING: a learning method mostly made by practice
- 3. COOPERATIVE LEARNING: learning by staying together

TIMETABLE

The workshop will be made of:

- An introductory meeting with icebreakers and team building games
- A meeting on recycling connected with gardening (vivaio Ibervillea)
- A meeting on recycling bicycle inner tubes (Baiskeli project)
- A meeting on recycling sartorial waste (TULIME)
- Final meeting with discussion on the workshop results



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During the meetings, the volunteers will collect audio/video materials that will be shared on YOU.COM platform. The volunteers, also after the workshop, will do activities of creative elaboration of all the materials collected that will be used for the dissemination of the project.
